**9 Privacy Information**

Voter registration records contain some information that is available to the public, such as your name, address, and age range. Your date of birth, driver license number, state identification card number, and social security number are available only to an authorized government entity. Your email address and phone number are also only available to an authorized government entity. Your request for additional privacy protection will be processed by the county clerk.

**REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL PRIVACY PROTECTION**

In addition to the protections provided above, you may request that your voter registration record be withheld from public disclosure if you are, or reside with: an individual who is a victim of, or is threatened with, domestic violence or dating violence; a law enforcement officer; a member of the armed forces; a public figure; or an individual who is protected by a court order. To make this request for additional privacy protection, you must prove that you qualify by submitting an at-risk designation request form, and any required proof, to your county clerk. You may obtain the form, and information on the proof required, from your county clerk or at [vote.utah.gov](http://vote.utah.gov).

Unless I have indicated above that I am preregistering to vote in a later election, I will be at least 18 years of age and will have resided in Utah for 30 days immediately before the election. I am not a convicted felon currently incarcerated for commission of a felony.

**Citizenship Affidavit:** I hereby swear and affirm, under penalties for voting fraud set forth below in Utah Code Section 20A-2-401, that I am a citizen and that to the best of my knowledge and belief the information above is true and correct.

**Is voter registration information confidential?**

Voter registration records are considered public records under Utah Code 63G-2-301(1)(l). A list of voters is available to the public upon request under Utah Code 63G-2-201. The section below (titled "How do I request additional privacy protection?") discusses additional privacy protections that are available to certain individuals. A few items remain confidential and are never provided to any requester: your Social Security number, your UT Driver License number or UT ID number, email address, phone number, full date of birth, and your signature. **How do I request additional privacy protection?**

You may request that identifying information on your voter registration records be withheld from all political parties, candidates for public office, and their contractors, employees, and volunteers, by submitting an at-risk request form, and any required verification, with this registration form, or to the Office of the Utah Lieutenant Governor or a county clerk.

Who can submit a withholding request form?

- A person who is a victim, or is likely to be a victim, of domestic violence or dating violence
- Law enforcement officers
- Individuals protected by protective or protection orders
- Members of the armed forces
- Public figures who have a higher safety risk due to their celebrity status or prominent position
- A person who resides with a person described in the bullet points above.

You can obtain an at-risk request form from your county clerk's office or the Office of the Utah Lieutenant Governor, or you may download the form online at [www.vote.utah.gov](http://www.vote.utah.gov).

**Proof of United States citizenship may be established by one of the following methods:**


- A Utah driver license number that verifies United States citizenship;
- A Utah state identification card number that verifies United States citizenship;
- A legible copy of your birth certificate that verifies United States citizenship;
- A legible copy of the pages of a United States passport that identifies you and your passport number;
- An alien registration number that verifies United States citizenship;
- A legible copy of your United States naturalization documents;
- A Bureau of Indian Affairs card number, tribal treaty card number, or tribal enrollment number;
- A legible copy of a certificate of degree of Indian blood or a Bureau of Indian Affairs affidavit of birth;
- Verification of citizenship from the Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements program, operated by the United States Department of Homeland Security; or
- Other documents or methods of proving United States citizenship that are established in accordance with the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986.

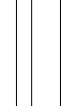
