The meeting was called to order at approximately 7:33 AM by Michele Corigliano, 1st Vice Chair of the Salt Lake County Board of Health.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

Environmental Health Regulation 21

A non-substantive clerical/grammatical error was discovered in Salt Lake County Health Department Health Regulation 21, Community Noise Pollution Control. The underlined word below will be added.

4.8.7 Public Assembly. Noise directly resulting from crowd noise associated with a public assembly is **exempted** from this Regulation.

Finance Committee

The Board of Health Finance Committee has been formed. They will meet before the next Board of Health Meeting to review June budget adjustments.

Program Reviews

Dorothy Adams, Zachary Stovall and Heather Edwards with the Health Department are leading program reviews. Currently they are focused on the Tuberculosis Program. The reviews are to evaluate program resources and efficiency. The findings will be presented to the Board as the reviews are finalized.

Strategic Planning

Dr. Angela Dunn updated the Board on the Health Department strategic planning process. All staff and partners were surveyed. Each Health Department Division will have in-person focus groups to understand their goals. When the strategic plan is complete it will be presented to the Board.
