The meeting was called to order at approximately 7:30 AM by Dan Eckersley, Chair of the Salt Lake County Board of Health.

Dan Eckersley, Chair, asked if there was a motion to approve the minutes from the April 4, 2024, Board of Health meeting. *A motion was made by Michelle Corigliano, seconded by Dr. Kencee Graves, to approve the minutes from the April 4, 2024, Board of Health meeting.* The motion passed unanimously, showing that all Board members present voted "Aye."

CHAIR'S REPORT:

Dan Eckersley notified the Board that the interview process is still happening in the search for an executive director for the Health Department.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

Ron Lund, Environmental Health Director of the Salt Lake County Health Department, gave the Director's Report.

Community Health Assessment

The Health Department is partnering with CommonSpirit to do a community health assessment. The Department will be using an Incident Command Structure in this planning to help practice emergency management.

Measles Update

Clinical Services has received free MMR doses from the State to proactively vaccinate individuals that need it.

Health Department Annual Meeting

The Health Department's Annual Meeting will be at the Hogle Zoo on May 10th and board members are invited to attend. The focus at this meeting will be helping employees learn about other programs in the department.

HHW Collection Center

The ribbon cutting for the new Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center in Sandy is tentatively scheduled for May 30th. An invitation will be sent when the details are confirmed.

Climate and Health Symposium

There was a successful Environmental Health Resiliency Symposium on April 30th. The gathering brought together experts, professionals and enthusiasts from various fields to discuss the impacts of climate change on human health.

Training Opportunities

Several members of the health department joined other local health department employees in two separate leadership courses. These courses provided an opportunity for staff to train in effective leadership.

Health Regulation #31:

Ron Lund updated the Board on Health Regulation #31, *Standards and Procedures for Adoption of Health Regulations*, and asked the Board to open the regulation for a thirty (30) day public comment period and assign a hearing officer.

Dan Eckersley, Chair, asked if there was a motion to Open Health Regulation #31 for a public hearing and assign a Hearing Officer. *A motion was made by Mayor Marcus Stevenson, seconded by Dr.*

Kencee Graves, to open Regulation #31 for a thirty (30) day public comment period and assign a hearing officer. The motion passed unanimously, showing that all Board members present voted “Aye.” Michele Corigliano volunteered to be the hearing officer.
