- 1. The coloring contest is open to children ages O-12. Parents and teens may join by coloring the bonus page.
- 2. To be eligible, entries must be original artwork with complete contact details and use traditional coloring tools (crayons, colored pencils, markers, etc.).
- 3. Participants must reside in Salt Lake County.
- 4. Children can color multiple pages, but may only submit one entry per program.
- 5. Submitting a program's page enters children into that program's prize drawing; however, submission does not guarantee a win.
- 6. Mail-in entries are accepted, but SLCoHD is not responsible for delayed or lost submissions.
- 7. The deadline for submissions is June 12, 2025. Any submissions received after this date will not be entered into the prize drawings.
- 8. Participants are only eligible to win once.
- 9. Winners will be contacted via email in mid-June with instructions for in-person prize pick up.
