She had not received a response from the Healthy Senior Collaborative, but when she does, she will forward to members via email. The agency responses will also be available for committee review on the "Extra" tab of the application in ZoomGrants TM . Karen also went over the new tracking within Zoomgrants TM regarding disclosure statements for each of the applications and how to input an intent to abstain or recuse.
